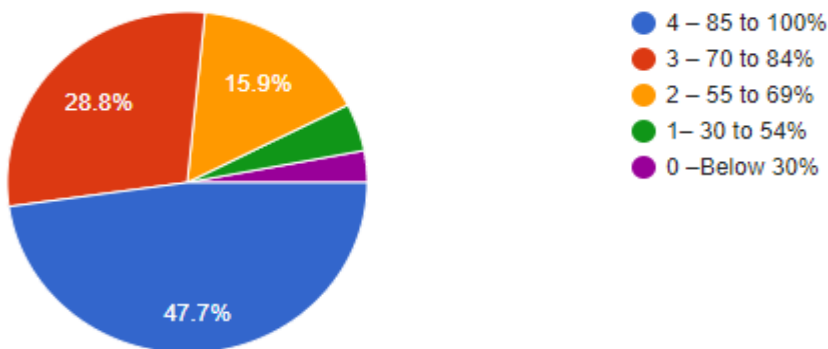


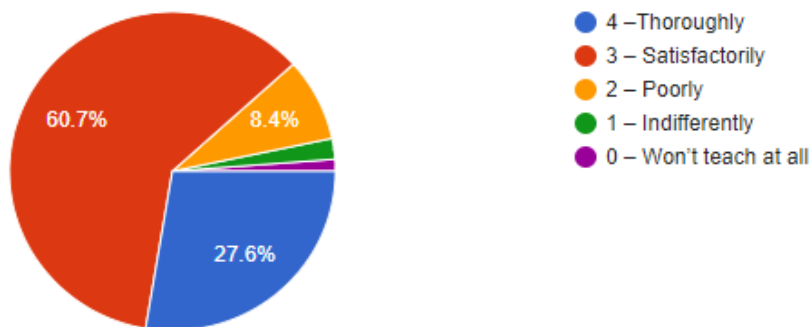

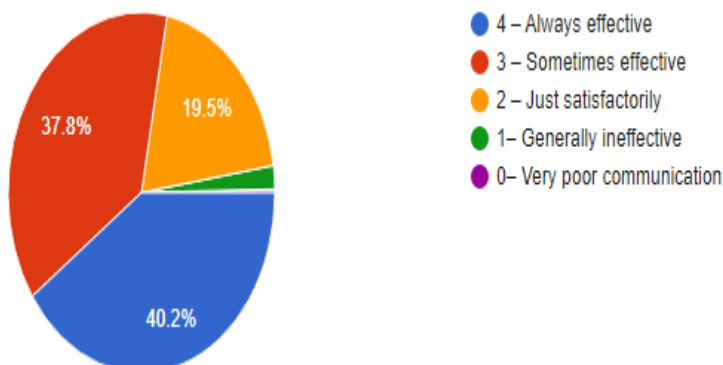
**Q. 1) How much of the Syllabus was covered in the Class?**

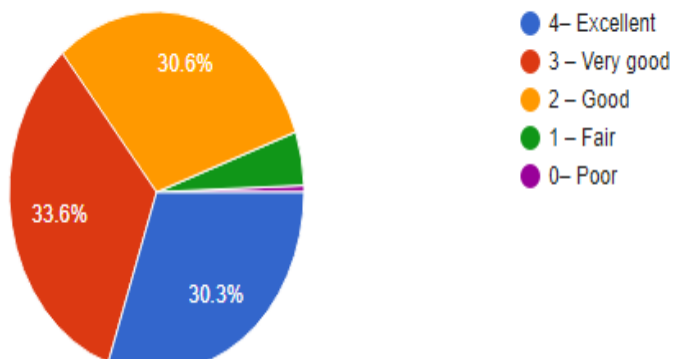
**Q.2) How well did the Teachers prepare for the Classes?**
