However, the law does not establish human rights. Human rights are inherent entitlements which come to every person as a consequence of being hurnan.. Treaties and other sources of law generally serve to protect uties are two formally the rights of individuals and groups against actions there is a or abandonment of actions by Governments which interfere t to life to a with the enjoyment of their human rights.

The Constitution of India is the supreme law of India. It defines the Government's fundamental political policies, processes, powers, rights, and duties. It conveys constitutional supremacy & not parliamentary supremacy because it is not established by the Parliament but by a constituent assembly and adopted by its citizens. with a declaration in its preamble. The human rights and fundamental rights, such as equality, liberty of thought and expression, belief, movement, communication and association of Indians are protected by the Indian constitution.

**Judiciary** is an important branch of the government of India. It is an independent body and is different from Executive and legislature. Judiciary operates in such a way that it keeps both the executive and legislature in their mandated role. The main function of the Indian Judiciary System is to deliver justice to the people of India. The Constitution establishes single integrated and a Independent judicial system for the whole India. The Indian Judiciary is the Interpreter of the Constitution of India, Guardian of fundamental rights and freedoms of the people of India. Indian constitution has established an integrated and Hierarchical judicial system. It has three level structures as:

- 1) Supreme Court
- 2) High Courts and
- 3) Subordinate Courts (District and Session Courts)
