The term "Divyang," was uttered by Mr. Narendra Modi, the Honourable Prime Minister of India. The Hindi word "divyang" means "one with a divine body part." In response to the prime minister, individuals who possess disabilities should no longer be referred to as viklang individuals or disabled people. The word seems highly unsuitable.

The Indian Constitution demands an inclusive society and ensures the equality, freedom, justice, and dignity of everyone, including people with disabilities. As such, the governance paradigm's strategy has always been proactive in fulfilling the needs of those in excluded circumstances and giving them equal chances over the board.
